2022-2023 IRS Data Retrieval Tool Instructions

The IRS Data Retrieval Tool should be used to verify tax information through the FAFSA.

- 1. To begin, go to <u>www.studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa</u>.
- 2. Log in using the student's FSA ID and password.
- 3. If the FAFSA has previously been submitted, click Edit FAFSA Form.
- In the Parent Financials section, select Already Completed if the parent's 2020 federal income tax return has already been completed and enter the Type of Tax Return Filed and the Tax Filing Status as listed on the 2020 federal income tax return.
- 5. Click **Proceed to IRS**. Provide parent's FSA ID credentials.
- 6. Enter all requested information <u>exactly</u> as it appears on the 2020 federal income tax return and click **Submit**.
- 7. Check the box for **Transfer My Tax Information into the FAFSA Form** and then click **Transfer Now.**
- 8. You will be redirected back to the FAFSA. You will know that your tax information has been successfully transferred because the words "Transferred from the IRS" will display in place of the IRS information on your FAFSA form. *
- 9. Repeat these steps in the **Student Financials** section if the student also filed a 2020 federal income tax return.
- Provide electronic signatures when prompted. Agree to terms and then click on SIGN & SUBMIT MY FAFSA (you will receive a confirmation page once you have completed submission).

If you are unable to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, you will need to either:

- Provide a 2020 Tax Return Transcript from the IRS. This can be requested online at <u>www.irs.gov</u> (click on Get Your Tax Record); by calling the IRS at 1-800-908-9946; or by completing IRS Form 4506-T.
- Provide a signed copy of your 2020 federal income tax return including Schedules 1, 2, and 3 (if applicable).
