CRRSAA Act, HEERF II---Award Summary

December 2020: The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) was enacted which allocated funds under the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERF II). The requirement for students to be Title IV eligible was eliminated.

The American Academy of Art College received an award of \$283,784 to be disbursed to students for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency cost due to the coronavirus, such as tuition, housing, health care, food or child care.

The institution signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement for requesting Emergency Aid Grants to students.

The funds for this grant award has been distributed to students for financial assistance with costs associated with educational expenses such as tuition, fees, technology expense, supplies, housing and miscellaneous items due the disruption of learning from COVID-19.

Funds were distributed to students in two phases-- phase one for those students who needed financial assistance; phase two was distributed on a prorated basis with amounts ranging from \$2,645 to \$560, students with the most need receiving the higher amount based on EFC range from the FAFSA.
